Dr Luke Streitberg is the Deputy Director of Prevocational Education and Training at The Canberra Hospital.

Dr Streitberg has been instrumental in the conversion of all teaching programs to online education sessions. This has doubled attendance in all three education programs for the JMOs at ACT Health. These sessions are available on a shared drive to ensure accessibility to those who cannot attend at any time.

Luke has implemented consult videos where he has engaged a registrar or consultant from various disciplines to record a video modelling an exemplary phone consultation. Currently there are 27 consult tip videos available for JMOs to view.

Dr Streitberg is responsible for the teaching program, 'Monday Shorts', which involves both small group teaching sessions on junior doctor led topics, with practical simulation sessions educating doctors about hands-on interventions.

Dr Streitberg is also involved in teaching niche subjects to JMOs, such as prison health, forensic medicine and medico-legal aspects of medical practice.

Dr Streitberg is a member of the Education Committee of the Canberra Region Medical Education Council, and represents ACT on CPMEC's Australasian Directors of Clinical Training Committee.
