

## **Geoffrey Marel Medal**

## Award criteria

The Geoffrey Marel Medal is awarded by CPMEC to honour the exceptional national and trans-Tasman contribution that the recipient has made to promoting prevocational training. The award is made annually and presented at the official dinner of the annual Prevocational Forum.

Nominees for the medal are judged on the following criteria:

- demonstrated leadership in prevocational training
- significant achievements or contributions in prevocational training
- significantly impacted on the work of CPMEC and Postgraduate Medical Councils (or equivalent body), and prevocational training in Australia and New Zealand
- the contributions have made been over a period of time
- is considered outstanding and worthy of this recognition
- have the consent of the person being nominated
