Dr Andrew Morton is a Junior House Officer at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (RBWH).

In this role Dr Morton has mentored many interns to enhance their clinical performance and confidence.

Andrew is a Clinical Tutor for University of Queensland medical students, as well as a facilitator at the UQ Intern Readiness Workshop for students.

Andrew has undertaken research outside of his clinical work, and has published 8 papers in the last two years - 3 as first author and 3 as second author. The outstanding quality of his research was recognised last year by the Société Internationale d'Urologie, and he was also the winner of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons Queensland Paper Prize last year.

Andrew has also undertaken research for the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital as a key collaborator in the COVIDSurg Project, an international collaborative database of patients who have undergone surgery during the pandemic, which will inform the management of this group and improve their clinical care.

Andrew has contributed to clinical care as a member of the Medicines Advisory Committee at RBWH to encourage the appropriate, equitable, safe and cost-effective use of medicines in the Hospital.
