

Dr Vu Huy NGUYEN – QLD



Dr Vu Nguyen is a Surgical Junior House Officer at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (RBWH).

As RBWH's Junior Medical Officer representative in 2019, Dr Nguyen collated feedback from that year's intern cohort and provided it to the Medical Education office, and attended the two JMO Forums. Vu helped prepare the RBWH Hospital Report detailing the orientation week experience and continued education and teaching experience which was then used to compare intern experiences with various hospitals across Queensland to enhance the internship experience.

Vu is an Associate Lecturer with the University of Queensland (UQ) and is actively involved in the mentoring and teaching of medical students. He has undertaken clinical coaching sessions with Year 2 medical students which involved supervising and teaching students how to perform history taking, clinical examinations, interpreting medical imaging and formulating diagnosis. Vu is on the panel for the Multiple Mini Interview for the UQ Faculty of Medicine admissions.

Vu has continued to pursue his passion for ophthalmology and has been active in helping out in the Eye Casualty Clinic. As an intern, he presented a paediatric surgical audit at the Queensland Children's Hospital and recently he was involved in collating data on the RBWH Cataract Audit.

Since 2013 he has travelled to Phnom Penh in Cambodia to do volunteer vision screening for the underprivileged with Australian Health Humanitarian Aid.

At university Vu was actively involved in the UQ global health group, the UQ Medical Society and the Australian Medical Students' Association.
